



WELCOME TO READY SET GO
"THE HEAT IS ON" FLYBALL WEEKEND
JUNE 25-26, 2011

A big NAPANEE welcome everybody to our "HEAT IS ON" Flyball tournament. Following is all the information you will need to make your weekend in Napanee a memorable one.

RACE VENUE: The Arena is open all day Friday for set up. It opens Saturday & Sunday morning @ 7:00am. Note: we will ask that you keep your dogs' on-leash while walking to & from the arena. The surrounding fairgrounds are for our use so please pick up after your dogs. Pooper bag stations will be setup throughout the fairgrounds.

NOTE: since we are located within an earshot of neighbors, we ask that you do as much as possible to control the barking around your campsite and while waiting to race

RACING: Racing starts at **8:30am Saturday** and **8:00am Sunday**

Regular 2, 3 and Open 1, 3 and Multi are Triple Round Robin - 3/5 format.

Open 2 is a Double Round Robin - 3/5 format and Reg 1 is Quadruple Round Robin - 3/5 format

One tournament point is awarded for each RACE win, 0 for each RACE loss in 3/5 racing.

TIES: **Two way** ties will be broken by previous head/head competition. Failing that, previous head/head fastest time. Finally, if the tie is still not broken, fastest tournament time will be used to determine placement. **Three or more way** ties will be broken by fastest tournament time.

If you have a 2-way radio, please check with the head table for the channel where we will broadcast the ON DECK races and other info daily. If you need additional time to switch team, just mention this to the judge. They have been made aware of some close racing and will allow some teams to recoup and be ready for their next race.

NOTE: The Racing schedule was created by the NAFA software and does not follow Appendix C of the NAFA rulebook 100%.

JUDGE: A BIG Napanee "Welcome" to our judges: Danielle Beauregard & Dianna Jaynes.

BOX JUDGING: RSG volunteers will try and cover these spots throughout the weekend but as we have a few teams in ourselves, we might on occasion need your help, so to say thank you in advance for your help, we will provide you with a raffle ticket if you box or line judge.

MEASURING: Saturday morning at **8:00am**.

WARM-UP: There will be a 2-minute warm up to start then reduced to one minute if needed to stay on schedule.

HOSPITALITY: We will have free coffee / tea and snacks each morning, served on the arena floor by the back entrance until 10:00am. For your lunch pleasure, a Hotdog stand will be on-site and offer hotdogs/sausages/drinks at a really cheap price. The venue does have a mezzanine on the upper floor where we will be hosting our Saturday Night Roasted Pork Loin Dinner & our sinful Chocolate fountain for dessert. The cost for the Dinner is a mere \$15.00 payable at the door for those who have replied back with guests' numbers. NO dogs allowed upstairs during dinner please. Dinner will be announced via 2-way radio when ready. **1 quick GREEN note:** in order to help minimize on garbage, we kindly ask that you bring a dinner plate if at all possible. We will have paper plates on-site if you forget.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented for 1st 2nd & 3rd placement in all divisions.

We also have some specialty awards to acknowledge certain participants.

Also, we will have a brag poster set out on the main floor for you to post your individual achievements i.e. titles. Keepsakes will be provided to those who reach new NAFA titles so make sure you let us know by 2pm Sunday so that your milestone may be acknowledged.

RAFFLE TABLE: Our members, friends & local businesses have gone above and beyond to bring you a great raffle table filled with many of those "must have" prizes. Draw is at 2pm, Sunday.

CAMPING: There are numerous electrical plug-ins and several water fill-up stations throughout the park. Signs will be posted to mark their locations. A washroom building in the lower section of the park is open all night for your convenience and comfort as well as some porta-potties in the upper section. Showers are available in the local Flying J. There is a \$20 per RV for the weekend for camping hook ups. No charge if you use a generator. Ready Set Go will place pay envelopes in your "welcome bags" so you may collect from your campers at your convenience and simply drop it off at the head table by on Sunday lunchtime. We thank you in advance for your cooperation. Tents not using the utilities will not be subject to those fees. There are dumping stations located at the Flying J, just a few minutes from the site.

DIRECTIONS: Napanee is located off the 401 Highway in between Belleville & Kingston, ON.

Heading EAST, exit the 401 Hwy at exit # 579 and turn LEFT (south) on Center Street at the light. Drive for ~2 Km to Thomas Street and turn RIGHT. Go to the end of Thomas St and enter the Fairgrounds. Camping areas are at the back. Follow the signs.

Heading WEST, exit the 401 Hwy at the second exit "Hwy 41" and turn RIGHT (south) on Center Street at the STOP. Drive for ~2.5 Km to Thomas Street and turn RIGHT. Go to the end of Thomas St and enter the Fairgrounds. Camping areas are at the back. Follow the signs.
